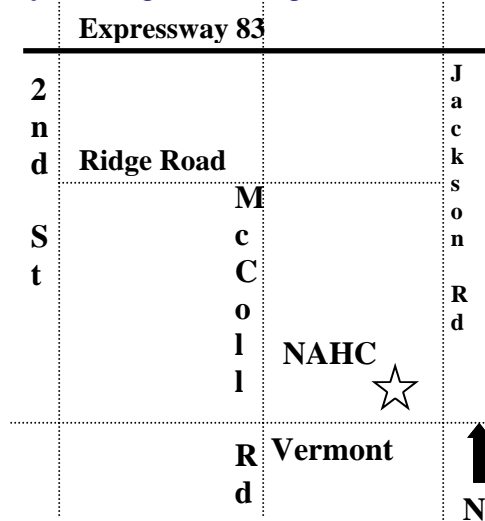
If you are driving EAST on Expressway 83:
