She is on the Editorial Board of Exceptional Parent and PT Products Magazine. She has presented at RESNA, Medtrade, APTA Annual Meeting and will be the keynote speaker at ISS in 2006. She is a doctoral candidate at the University of Maryland and has published extensively.

This course will concentrate on seating and positioning of the very young (0-5) using case studies and exploring equipment components and their impact on specific abnormalities and diagnoses.
